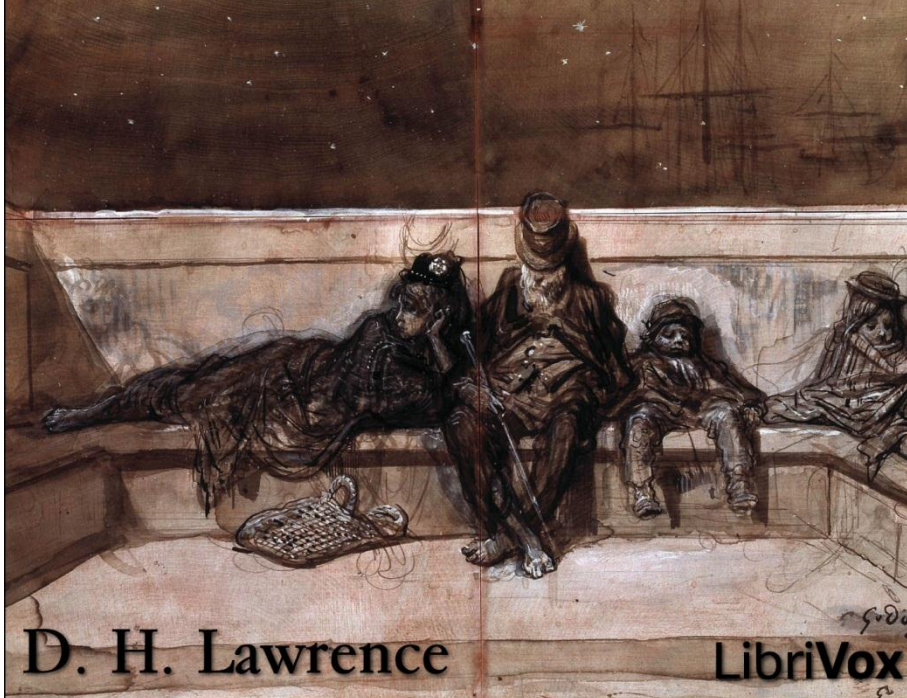


Embankment at Night, before the War: Outcasts
